Dear Colleagues,

I've spent more than two decades working closely with the legal profession, and I've seen the pressure lawyers carry every day. The truth is: **lawyers study law, but they were never taught how to practise law with technology**, yet today they are expected to deliver faster, cheaper, and with far more transparency.

I built **eLitigation** from inside a litigation department, and later **Casengine**, which grew rapidly during COVID when firms had no choice but to go digital. That period proved something important: when legal work becomes digital, the profession evolves. But once the crisis passed, many firms returned to fragmented tools, emails, and spreadsheets.

Now AI is accelerating the industry, but **AI alone is not the solution**. The real problem in legal today is **data**: we lack clean, structured, continuously generated legal data. And **AI is only as strong as the data behind it**.

That is why I am building **LegalOS** not another tool, and not an AI shortcut, but a **Legal Operating System** that helps lawyers practise law fully in a digital environment, end-to-end. We are already using AI where it genuinely helps today, but the real transformation happens as firms build their own structured data over time, allowing AI to become reliable, meaningful, and firm-specific.

The next generation of lawyers is already thinking with AI. They will demand systems that are structured, connected, and intelligent, without losing the human judgment and ethics that define our profession.

During COVID, as firms had to go digital, adoption accelerated and validated the market need for connected legal operations. CASENGINE reached strong commercial traction and at its peak was valued at USD 28M.

Built one of the region's earliest litigation automation platforms from inside a working litigation department.

It digitised the end-to-end litigation workflow and proved a core lesson that shaped everything after: lawyers adopt technology when it matches legal logic and daily practice not when it feels like IT.

# eLitigation - Building Legal Operations from Inside a Law Firm



2002

**Office in Dubai World Trade Center**  
Internal mail dominated, email was new, dial-up internet, Netscape & AOL days no iPhone or Galaxy, Nokia led. Digital platforms didn't exist yet.

**First day in the region's largest law firm Al Tamimi & Co.**  
Joined the firm in 2002 and experienced legal work at scale litigation, corporate, operations, and client delivery before "digital" was even a thing.



eLitigation plan was ready. The first LegalTech project plan was prepared for execution!

eLitigation went live and changed how litigation teams worked. It automated the litigation workflow end-to-end and connected multiple departments to one structured process.
